From The Office

If your child is sick please do not send them to school. Sick children need rest, the comfort of home and their parents giving them TLC. If they require medication for the most part this indicates they should be at home recovering from illness. There are of course exceptions to this and your doctor will advise you in this instance.

On the rare occasion your children require medication at school there are procedures that need to be followed. First and foremost **children should not carry their medication with them in their school bags (the only exception to this is an asthma inhaler).**

Parents should come to the office in the morning if it is necessary for their child to have medicine at school that day. There is paperwork to be completed and the medication will be stored safely in the office and administered as instructed. **Parents are required to collect the medication at the end of the school day. For safety reasons we are unable to give medication to children to take home.** Thank you for following these important procedures for the safety of all our students.
